Are you a **United States Citizen** between the **ages of 14 and 24** years old and are planning or would like to go to college or trade school?

Would you like information and assistance with Obtaining Scholarships, College Entrance Requirements, Enrollment Procedures and Financial Assistance?

Would you like to receive training with occupational tools needed for Allied Health or Industrial Careers?

Would you like a Kit to get you started in your chosen career path?

Participants that complete the program will receive "kits" which will contain tools that they will need for careers in Allied Health or Industrial Careers.

For example, those pursuing careers in Nursing or Allied Health will receive a stethoscope or other related tool. Individuals planning on pursuing an Industrial Career can receive a wrench set or other valuable tools and equipment.

How does this Work?

Interested individuals will complete an application and provide staff with their Birth Certificate to prove U.S. Citizenship. Individuals under 18 must have a parent or legal guardian present for application process.

Once enrolled in the program participants will attend two 2 ½ hour classes held at the **Alvin Community College Campus; available at Both Alvin and Pearland locations.**

Participants will also be provided with **Mentorship** sessions from a skilled professional which will address multiple questions and concerns with regard to; **College Enrollment, Exploration of Career Paths, Obtaining and Retaining Employment, Personal Responsibility and Other Services Available in the Community.**
